Official Rules

- The contest is open to students who are residents of Lake or McHenry counties in Illinois or Kenosha county in Wisconsin and/or members of Great Lakes Credit Union.
- All students in grades K-6 may participate.
- Entries will be judged in two groups: K-2 and 3-6.
- Two Grand Prize Winners will be chosen, one from each of the two age groups. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place winners will also be chosen from the two age groups.
- Entries will be accepted no later than Friday, March 21st, 2008 at 5:00pm.
- Entries may be rendered in the following art mediums: pen, pencil, marker, crayon, or paint and must be on 8.5”x11” unlined paper.
- The winning entries will be determined by a panel of judges whose decisions are final. Originality, design and theme topic will determine winning entries.
- All entries become the property of Great Lakes Credit Union. Grand Prize winners artwork will be re-produced for a limited time on Great Lakes Credit Union drive-up envelopes, and may be reproduced for the purposes of press releases and announcements on our website. Names and schools of finalist entries will be used in our press releases. Names, schools, and photos of winners will be posted on our website, Kidsville News, sponsored by Halnik Publishing, and/or used in other press releases.
- Schools will be provided with the addresses of all Great Lakes Credit Union Branches where entries may be submitted. By mail, send entries to GLCU Attn: Susan Malo 2525 Green Bay Road, North Chicago, IL 60064.
- Child’s name, school, grade, and telephone number (for purposes of contacting finalists) must be clearly printed on the reverse side of all posters. (Teacher’s if you are submitting entries for your entire class, your contact information is sufficient)
- Children of GLCU employees and or of its partners or affiliates, including grandchildren, nieces and nephews are eligible to enter but will not be eligible for the Grand Prizes or 1st, 2nd or 3rd place.
- No multiple entries will be eligible for prizes.
- Winners will be announced at the Awards Ceremony to be held Saturday, April 26th at the Waukegan Public Library, 128 North County Street, Waukegan, IL 60085 at 10:00 a.m. All finalists in attendance will receive a Certificate of Achievement and small giveaway.
